

Details for website:

These are the latest versions of the OAHI & CAHPI-Ontario logos. More than likely, more will be added soon.

The colour files are cmyk 300 dpi for printing purposes. RGB formatted files will be up shortly.

They are all around 1.5 inches tall - but do not use any of the jpegs more than 200 percent for any kind of output except personal printers.

Use only the eps for any posters - banners - letter heads - business cards - actually anything you send to a printer of any kind make sure it is the eps for the sharpest cleanest output and look.

The black and white logos are greyscale 300 dpi. Any one wanting to use them and are not sure - put them all on one page of the application you want to use them in at the size or sizes want and print them out as a test.

Anyone trying to open or convert them in Corel or Freehand (they use a different colour space and will convert the colour break down of these files to that application) must be responsible for making sure the grey in some of the logos is 40 percent and that the Red colour is cyan-0 magenta-100 yellow-91 black-0.

Always make your printer is responsible for the correct reproduction of your logo. Any change - colour - size - position etc has to have signed authorization. Always sign off on a proof. Otherwise do not pay and make them redo the job. If you cannot get there for an approval, make sure when you provide the file for the job you also supply them a previous printed piece and tell them it has to match.

Of course the best thing you can do is to not always leave it to the last minute.

Make sure all other logos are trashed or at least not on the computer an individual is using. The creation date of the logo should be your indicator that these are the current and only logos to use.
